<b>PROGRAM DESCRIPTION</b>		
<p>Public Education &amp; Business Coalition (PEBC) is a Colorado-based 501(c)3 organization that provides professional development services for practicing educators locally and nationally, and operates the Boettcher Teacher Residency (BTR) for training well-qualified new teachers for high-needs schools. <p><b>ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand and be comfortable designing, planning, delivering and assessing instruction that meets the standards of Higher Education, Adam's State University, INTASC and the Boettcher Teacher Residency Program</li> <li>• Ensure that the instruction delivered meets the NCTQ and requirements as well as Colorado State and INTASC Standards for Teacher Preparation</li> <li>• Collaborate with the Associate Director and external experts to ensure the standards are being met for all endorsement instruction</li> <li>• Collaborate with the Associate Director to provide instruction for both Boettcher Teacher Residency and Adaptive Leadership as needed in person, at Resident Seminars and On Line via Canvas or other adopted platform (this will require the instructor to teach evening classes)</li> <li>• Collaborate with Resident Coaches, Site Coordinators and Mentors to ensure residents are prepared for the rigors of their classroom experiences</li> <li>• Provide on-site coaching for the Adaptive Leadership program as required by the outlined course work</li> <li>• Provide meta coaching for the Adaptive Leadership Program as required by the outlined course work</li> <li>• Participate in BTR Match Day and Summer Institute planning, coordination, facilitation and implementation</li> <li>• Engage and Participate in organizational events for both BTR and PEBC</li> <li>• Other duties as assigned</li> </ul>
